WHAT DOES IT COST?

Lightwave Emerge is part of a registered Charity and non-profit company (CIO) and funded entirely by grants and local donations.

Our running costs for 2022 are about £65,000 and this includes all our costs from venue hire, food & resources, paid and volunteer staff costs, to insurance, admin and training.

We are incredibly fortunate to have funding from a Church of England grant which has enabled us to start up, which currently covers over 95% of our activities until the end of 2024, but after that the work needs to be self-supporting from grants and particularly donations. We also have generous funding for Little Borrowers and Singing Ducklings from East Suffolk District Council but we want to do so much more.

WILD EMERGE

Little Bealings Borrowers is a wildlife afterschool group for families working in the churchyard on Wednesdays, 'Doing something small to be part of something big'. We improve biodiversity and reflect on the beauty of nature and God the creator. We also have a growing project, providing herbs, salad and strawberries for the church café.
